- The <del> tag is used to define the deleted text.
- Delete tag is markup updates and modifications in a document.
- The <del> tag supports both **Global Attributes** and **Event attributes**.
- <del> tag belongs to Flow content and Phrasing content Category.

### Syntax for <del> tag in HTML:

<del>Content here...</del>
