

<title> - TAG IN HTML WITH EXAMPLE

Definition of <title> tag:

- <title> tag is used to define the **title** of the HTML document.
- To show the title of the page in browser title bar the <title> tag is used.
- <title> tag belongs to **meta content category**.
- The title tag supports **Global Attributes**.

Syntax for <title> tag:

```
<title>Content</title>
```

Sample coding for <title> tag:

```

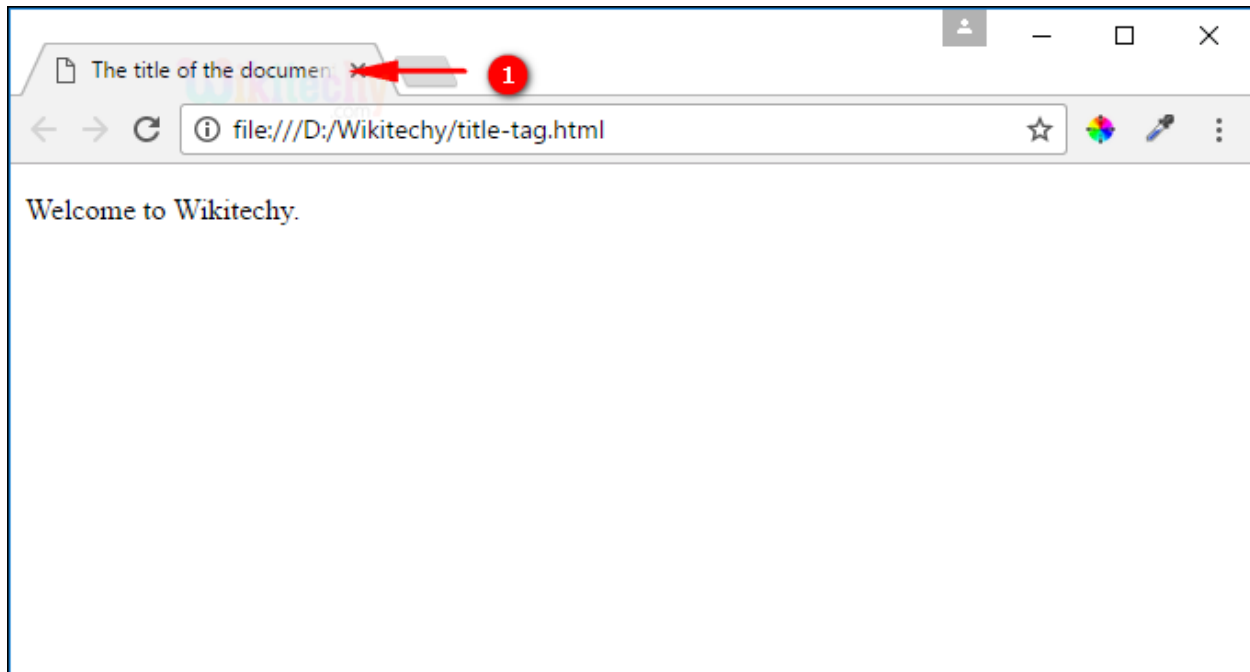


Code Explanation for <title> tag:
