

multiple Attribute in HTML

- The multiple attribute is a Boolean attribute.
- The multiple attribute is used to specify that the user is allowed to enter / select more than one value.
- Hence the Multiple attribute is new in HTML5 version.

Syntax for multiple Attribute in HTML:

```
<input type= "file" multiple>
```

Sample coding for multiple Attribute:

```
<!DOCTYPE html>  
<html>  
  <body>  
    Select files: <input type="file" name="img" multiple>  
    <input type="submit">  
    <p>Try selecting one or more when browsing for files.</p>  
  </body>  
</html>
```

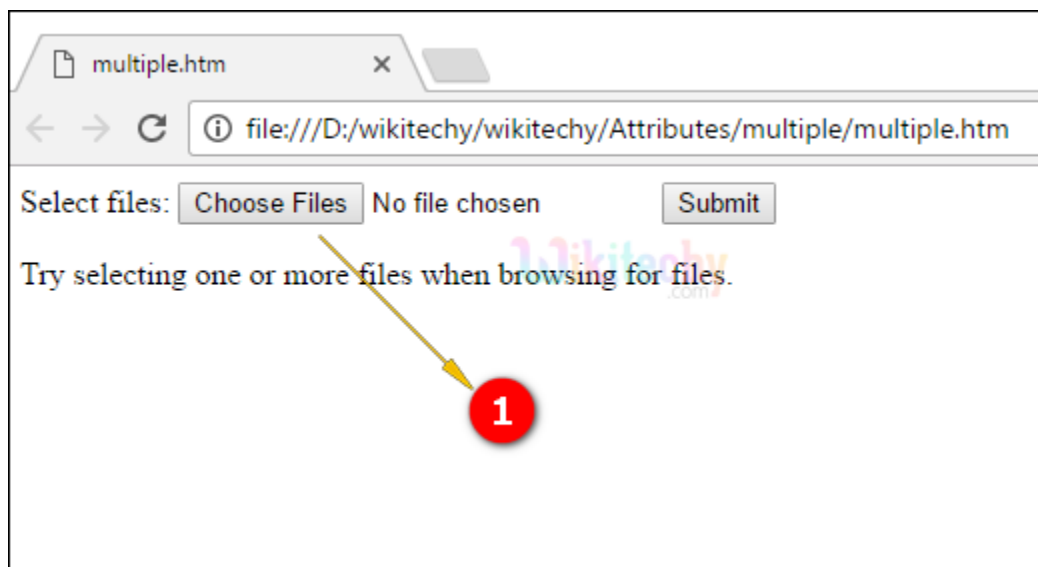


Code Explanation for multiple Attribute:
